How to Use the Law Enforcement Family Support Modules

The Law Enforcement Family Support modules were created in response to a state wide work force survey conducted in 2008-2009. The survey asked administrators, officers and family members to identify topics and information that would increase family members understanding of the officer's job responsibilities and stressors and more effectively prepare officers and families to positively respond to events that impact the families behind the badge.

How to use the modules

Law Enforcement Officers and Family Members

- Individually access and use web based modules and web site resources
- Use modules in law enforcement family gatherings as training and current topic information
- Use Law Enforcement Family Support web based resources to support orientation of law enforcement families and their officers
- Refer to modules to identify additional reading and resources
